Opening Questions

Getting into the text

Read Luke 17:5-10

- What prompted the disciples to say,' increase our faith'? (you might find it helpful to look at the verses which come before)
- How did Jesus respond? What encouragement would his words have given them (and us)?
- In verses 7 to 10 what was Jesus telling the disciples about the way they should serve? Thinking of some of Jesus' other teaching, how do you think this would be different from the servant master relationship they would have been familiar with in their society?

Applying the Bible to your life

•	What are some of the things which might hold you back from taking
	steps of faith which might bring about big changes?

• How do you keep your faith growing day by day? Is there something you could do as a group to encourage each other?

• If you had to write your job description as a servant of Jesus, what would you include? How would you explain its importance to someone who objects to the servant/master relationship?
