Opening Questions

- What is the best invitation you have ever had? What made it so special?
- What made you decide to become a follower of Jesus?

Getting into the text

Read John 1:29-42

- Why did John describe Jesus as the 'Lamb of God'?
- What do you think he meant in verse 30 when he said, 'This is the one I meant when I said, A man who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me'?
- How did John know that the one who came was Jesus?

- What do you think happened during the day which the two disciples spent with Jesus? Why were they convinced that Jesus was the Messiah?
- What was the first Andrew did after meeting with Jesus?

Applying the Bible to your life

- The disciples were convinced about who Jesus was after spending time with him. How easy do you find it to put aside time to spend with Jesus? Are there some small, simple practices you could put into place to help you with this?
- How can you help others to 'come and see' who Jesus is?

Something to pray about

Towards the end of his gospel the disciple John wrote, '**Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.**' (John 20:30-31)

- Give thanks to God for the freedom you have to learn more about Jesus through reading the Bible.
- Pray for those witnessing to Jesus in dangerous and difficult places where freedom is limited.
- Ask God to show you who you can invite to come and see Jesus.
